PASTOR'S PEN

Basking in the Beauty of God's Joy
"The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies
never come to an end;
they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."
Lamentations 3:22-23

The dreariness of Winter is wearing off. Warm breezes carrying the promise of Summer are beginning to swirl. Mornings are filled with the chirping chorus of birds eager to welcome the brightness of dawn. Flowers and trees are dressing the landscape in the glorious beauty of color. Spring has sprung. It is not out of compliment that lovers keep on telling one another how beautiful they are; the delight is incomplete till it is expressed." (*Reflection on the Psalms*, p. 95)

Let yourself be open to the rejuvenating effect of God's joy. And don't be satisfied merely with the experience of this joy, but seek out those with whom you can eagerly express joy. Then, your joy shall be complete and full.

Advocacy / Interpretation / Translation English as a Second Language Classes A Community Resource Liaison Women's Support Group
