The Heidelberg Catechism – Day 35: Questions 96-98

Leader: What is God’s will for us in the Second Commandment?

All: That we in no way make any image of God, nor worship Him in any other way than He commands in His Word.

Leader: Are we not allowed to make any image at all, then?

All: God cannot and may not be visibly portrayed in any way. While images of creatures may be made, God forbids any such images be made of Him. This prevents us from worshipping and serving the image in place of God.

Leader: Are images allowed in the churches as teaching aids for the uneducated?

All: Certainly no images of God. For God wants His people instructed by the preaching and teaching of His Word, not by idols which are unable talk.
