# **Maundy Thursday Litany**

## **Invitation to Worship**

On this day Christ the Lamb of God gave himself into the hands of those who would slay him. On this day Christ gathered with his disciples in the upper room.

On this day Christ took a towel and washed his disciples' feet, giving us an example that we should do to others as he has done to us. On this day Christ our God gave us this holy feast, that we who eat this bread and drink this cup may here proclaim his holy sacrifice and be partakers of his resurrection and at the last day may reign with him in heaven.

Song of Praise: In Christ Alone

Confession: (with an opportunity for silent confession)

Lord Jesus, like Judas, we have betrayed you; like Peter we have denied you; and like the other disciples we have forsaken you. Yet you remain faithful to us unto death, even death on a cross. We plead for your forgiveness and mercy... (silent confession)

In your faithfulness, we ask that you strengthen us so that we do not turn aside but follow you to the very end—for the final victory belongs to you. **Amen.** 

**Pardon:** Luke 23:32-34
