If ever you are faced with “giants” that are daunting and seemingly insurmountable...

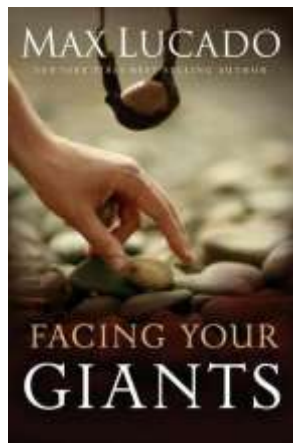
Then, this study is for you!

Come for *ONE* day, *TWO* days or *WHATEVER*
you can! It's gonna be fun!!!

Have you always wanted to work with clay? Bead? Silk paint? Or maybe, paint with shaving cream (no kidding!)?

There will be ample opportunity to exercise your 'inner artist' while studying the Genesis creation story during Creation Art Camp, from Sunday July 17 through Thursday, July 21.

There will be offerings for **everyone** – Trinity members and non-members, **preschool to adults** 'of a certain age'. Sunday evening we'll gather over dinner, followed by a brief presentation of the creation story by Pastor Steve. Then the preschool and kindergarten-aged children will go into groups to make creation books and experience soft foam clay and shaving cream painting.

The school-aged children and adults who want to do 'hands on' art will enjoy different stations including several pottery creations, glue painting on canvas, church banners, silk painting, and bead-ing.

Since the Creation Art Camp extends over five days there will be time to dive into a variety of art forms.

For those who prefer a more traditional Bible study of the Genesis creation story, Pastor Steve will offer such an experience.
