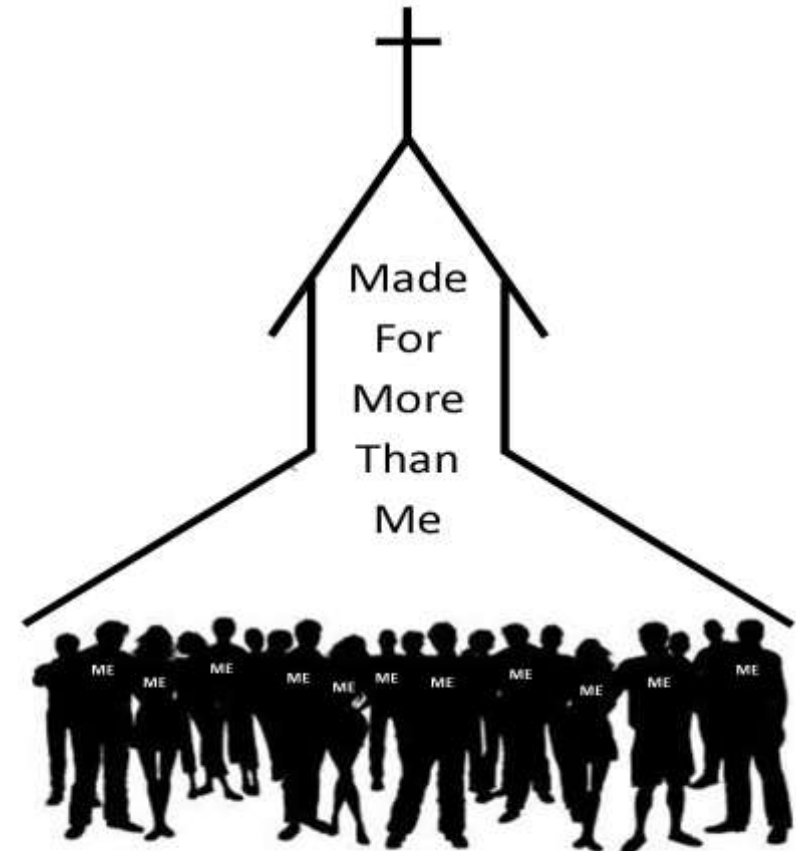

***CONFESSING OUR FAITH:** The Heidelberg Catechism – Day 25: Questions 65-68
Leader: If by faith alone we share in Christ’s blessings, where does this faith come from?
All: The Holy Spirit produces it in our hearts by the preaching of the Gospel, and confirms it in us as we participate in the holy sacraments.
Leader: What are the sacraments?
All: Sacraments are holy signs and seals for us to see. God established them, so that as we participate in them, we might understand more clearly the promise of the Gospel, and might trust God’s promise more deeply. And this is God’s Gospel promise: to forgive our sins and give us eternal life by grace alone through the finished work of Christ on the cross.
Leader: How many sacraments are there? And how do they point us to Jesus Christ?
All: There are two sacraments: baptism and the Lord’s Supper. In each, the Holy Spirit assures us and enables us to see that our entire salvation rests on Christ’s one sacrifice for us on the cross.
