Suggested Items

- Larger (WOW) items: Soccer ball (deflated) with pump, Stuffed animal, Toys puppets, trucks, etc.), Doll (baby, Barbie, etc.), Musical instrument, Outfit, Shoes
- **Toys:** toy cars, yo-yos, jump ropes, balls, toys that light up and make noise (with extra bat teries), etc.
- School Supplies: pens, pencils and sharpeners, crayons, markers, notebooks, paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, etc.
- Non-liquid Hygiene Items: toothbrushes, bar soap, combs, washcloths, etc.


