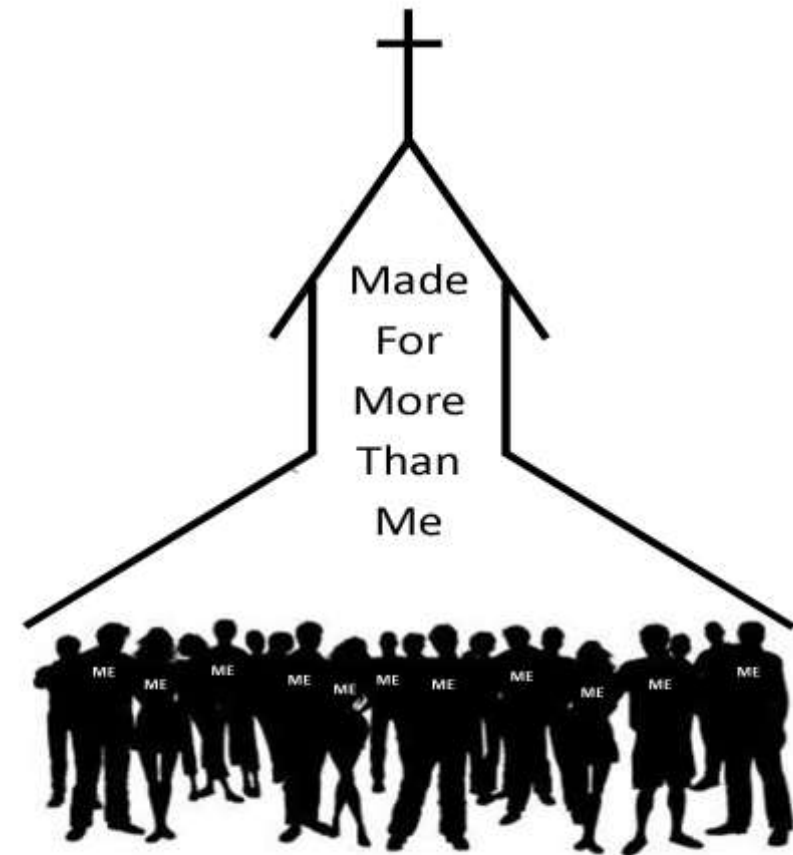

Verse 3

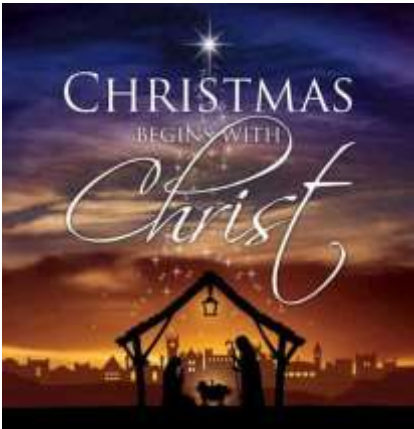
I wish for you my friend this happiness that I've found
