#### Will You Be That Friend?

He got up, took his mat and walked out in full view of them all. This amazed everyone, and they praised God, saying, "We have never seen anything like this!" (Mark 2:12 NIV)



For probably most of his life, a man was paralyzed and unable to get about on his own. Dependent on the kindness of others for every need, his life was full of discouragement and defeat, questions and doubts, pain and struggle. Until one day, this broken person met a beautiful Savior.



The event is described in Mark 2:1-12. Take some time to read it. You'll see that Jesus' popularity was growing such that wherever he went crowds followed him. On this occasion, a swelling mass of spectators gathered to hear Jesus. The house was packed full, the entire surrounding yard was crammed with people. Buffeted by the crowd, one person desperately needed Jesus, but was unable to get close to him, if it weren't for their friends....

Many elements in this story are amazing (the crowds, the healing miracle performed by Jesus, the reaction of the people, etc.). But what strikes me most is the devoted friends of the paralyzed man. These friends, who so loved and supported and cared for their paralyzed friend, would not be denied by the crowds. They defiantly desired to get him to Jesus, unwilling to be hindered by the people or thwarted by the circumstance. Carrying the paralyzed man many miles to the house, enduring the struggle to get him on top of the house, and digging through the roof, these friends lowered the man down into the midst of the crowd right in front of Jesus.

You can read the story, and I hope you do. Next to Jesus' unbelievable compassion for the broken and unrivaled correction of those who contradict the things of God, notice the devotion of this man's friends. Undoubtedly, the Lord is willing and able to change the life of anyone who comes to him. But, what brings a person to Jesus? People do: family

members, friends, coworkers, you and me...we are those who introduce others to this incredible and loving and beautiful Savior. Without friends like this, absent of those who willingly faced the obstacles of our brokenness and unbelief, would we have ever met the beautiful Savior?

So then, will you be that friend to others?

#### SUNDAY HOUR IN GUATEMALA

During the Sunday School hour of March 25th, Palm Sunday, Trinity will be hosting a presentation by Barney Hale, brother of Sandra Hollensead, in the Fellowship Hall. Barney will be speaking from 9:45 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. during the Sunday School hour. Sunday School classes are invited to attend, along with our congregation. Barney is a member of the Kirk of Kildaire Presbyterian Church in Raleigh.NC. Members have been visiting Pala Village, Guatemala, twice a year to help improve living conditions. Barney is not a missionary, but has a unique Missions focus in the Pala Village, where he has organized a group of Mayan Women Weavers who make scarves and other textiles to sell in the United States. Many of our members are familiar with this effort and have already supported Pala Village women and families by purchasing a scarf at Presbyterian Women events. All proceeds of these sales are returned to the women of the weaving group. Barney has lots of information to share.

We will also be taking up a special donation for Sandi and Brian Thompson-Royer, missionaries through the Presbyterian Church USA for their work with Presbyterian Women in Guatemala in 2018. You may remember they gave us a presentation during a "Coffee Meet and Greet' two years ago. 


