—2 Corinthians 8:2, NRSV

Paul arges the new believers in Corinth to understand that in their freedom, God will be with them. He reminds them that the Christian community in Macedonia has responded generously out of extreme poverty. Elsewhere Paul reminds the Corinthians that God loves a person who gives with joy and that God is able to bless them abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that they need, they will abound in every good work (2 Cor. 9.7-8).

Our giving can become selective, inconsistent, impulsive, and begrudging. We are often moved with companion following a disaster, a sense of duty when the church roof needs to be implaced, or feelings of obligation when an appeal is made for Christmas and Easter offerings

Paul invites bearers to give joyfully and generously. God will make it possible for all to overflow in generosity, whether that means giving two coins or an amount never before considered possible.

- What habits have you developed in your giving? How can you further develop your giving as a faithful practice in Christian discipleship?
- What personal story would you most like to tell others about where you have found joy in giving?
