From TPW: Do We Make a Difference?

The young girl came to Wellstone Regional Hospital with no place to call home and no possessions. Anthony Aemmer, the nurse director, put an empty duffle bag in front of her. "This is empty now," he said, "but I offer you a way to fill it". The girl had been taken from foster care for hitting others and punching walls. During each step of her counseling, she earned rewards that included two Best Buddies and three pillowcases. Clothing and hygiene items were also earned. The bag was full when the day came for discharge to her next home, and the newly learned self-discipline was the best reward of all.

Wednesday, March 13, members of Sew 'n Sews delivered 208 Best Buddies, 112 Pillowcases, 8 Blankets, and 1 drawstring bag to Wellstone. Anthony met with us, testifying to the value of Trinity's gifts in counseling those with mental and behavioral illnesses. The Bibles were very appreciated, as patients are not allowed books while in the hospital, but Bibles are exceptions. Thank you Sisters in Christ Sunday School class for the Bibles, and thank you Trinity for your support. Together, we *are* making a difference.
