



## **Elders**

Throughout the Old Testament, elders were established for governing God's people. The role of elders continued in the New Testament as those who discerned the leading of the Holy Spirit and cared for God's people. Accordingly, congregations should elect persons of wisdom and maturity of faith, having demonstrated skills in leadership and being compassionate in spirit. - Chair or co-chair a standing committee, and serve as a member of the Personnel Committee if chairing a committee with staff reporting to it.
- Attend a Presbytery Meeting as a representative of TPC (once or twice during term).
- Continue to study and strengthen their walk of faith in Christ.

### Deacons

The ministry of deacons as set forth in Scripture is one of compassion, witness, and service, by sharing the redeeming love of Christ to the poor, the hungry, the sick, the lost, the friendless, the oppressed, those burdened by unjust policies or structures, or anyone in distress. Persons of spiritual character, honest reputation, exemplary lives, brotherly and sisterly love, sincere compassion, and sound judgement should be chosen for this ministry.
