Operation Warm Feet



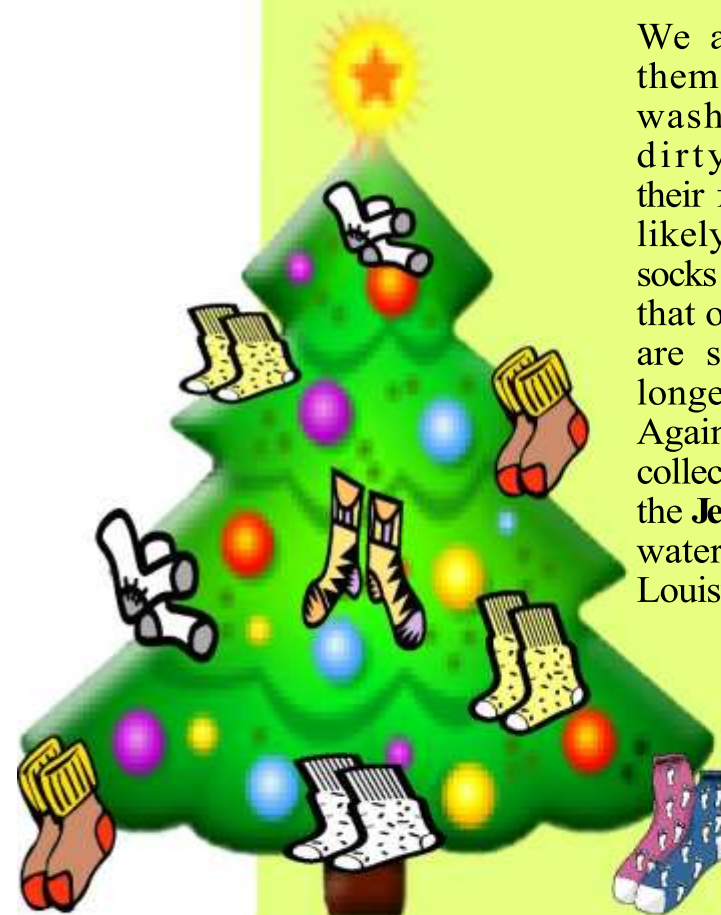
