



The Purpose and Occasion of 1 Peter

The Apostle Peter wrote this letter to scattered Christians whose faith was wearying under heavy hardships, growing persecution, and an intensifying isolation from fellow believers.

Peter writes these believers to root them in the truth about Jesus Christ, to urge them to live boldly for Christ, and to continue spreading the Living Hope of Jesus among their lost neighbors.
