Ecclesiastes 12:1-8

¹ Remember also your Creator in the days of your youth, before the evil days come and the years draw near of which you will say, "I have no pleasure in them"; 2 before the sun and the light and the moon and the stars are darkened and the clouds return after the rain, ³ in the day when the keepers of the house tremble, and the strong men are bent, and the grinders cease because they are few, and those who look through the windows are dimmed, ⁴ and the doors on the street are shut—when the sound of the grinding is low, and one rises up at the sound of a bird, and all the daughters of song are brought low—⁵ they are afraid also of what is high, and terrors are in the way; the almond tree blossoms, the grasshopper drags itself along, and desire fails, because man is going to his eternal home, and the mourners go about the streets—⁶ before the silver cord is snapped, or the golden bowl is broken, or the pitcher is shattered at the fountain, or the

Ever Before Your Eyes

- 1. Life's Dooming Demand v. 1
 - a. Remember your Creator...
 - b. While you are yet young
- 2. Life's Dwindling Decline v. 2-7
 - a. The passage of time intensifies the shortness of life (v. 2)
 - b. Age diminishes our strength and dims our faculties (v. 3-4)
 - c. Get up and go has gone (v. 5)
 - d. The good goes to the grave (v. 6-7)
- 3. Life's Dismal Deficiency v. 8

¹ If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. ² Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. ³ For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. ⁴ When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.
