





1 Peter 2:4-12

⁴ As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and precious, ⁵ you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. ⁶ For it stands in Scripture:

“Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone,
a cornerstone chosen and precious,
and whoever believes in him will not be put
to shame.”

⁷ So the honor is for you who believe, but
for those who do not believe,

“The stone that the builders rejected
has become the cornerstone,”

⁸ and

“A stone of stumbling,
and a rock of offense.”

They stumble because they disobey the
word, as they were destined to do.

⁹ But you are a chosen race, a royal
priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his
own possession, that you may proclaim the
excellencies of him who called you out of
darkness into his marvelous light. ¹⁰ Once
you were not a people, but now you are God’s
people; once you had not received mercy, but
now you have received mercy.

¹¹ Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and
exiles to abstain from the passions of the
flesh, which wage war against your soul. ¹²
Keep your conduct among the Gentiles
honorable, so that when they speak against
you as evildoers, they may see your good
deeds and glorify God on the day of
visitation.

A LIVING HOPE: Hope and the Family of God *1 Peter 2:4-12*

A Divine Foundation – v. 4, 6-8

As we come to Christ, He becomes the cornerstone of our
life.

A Divine Design – v. 5, 6-8

When Christ is the cornerstone of our life, He designs us
to be a “place” of worship.

A Divine Identity – v. 9-11

Because we are designed as a place of worship, we are
given an new identity as God’s people.

A Divine Distinction – v. 12-13

Now that we have a new identity as God’s people, we are
to embody a distinctly honorable lifestyle.
