What is the church?

Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed: "We believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic church..."

Oneness

The church is characterized by unity.

Jesus's high priestly prayer (John 17:11, 21-23) Paul's exhortation to us as the church to expe-

rience unity (Eph. 4:3-6)

2. Historically, the early church especially understood this oneness in relation to sound doctrine.

3. 500 years ago, the Protestant Reformers reenvisioned this attribute of unity.

Practically speaking, how does unity express itself in our church?

Holiness

Unlike the world and its character of sinfulness, the church is characterized by holiness.

Paul's address to the worldly, carnal Corinthians (1 Cor. 1:2)

Confirmed by Peter (1 Pet. 2:9)

In light of this positional holiness, the church must live out its holiness practically (1 Pet. 1:14-16)

2. Historically, this matter-of-fact unholiness did not stop early church leaders from calling their members to break from their sinfulness and pursue purity, underscoring this attribute.

3. 500 years ago, the Protestant Reformers objected to the Roman Catholic Church's notion of holiness.

4. Aware of the fragmentary nature of its present holiness, the church yearns for its future unveiling (Rev. 21:2)

5. Practically speaking, how does holiness express itself in our church ?



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
