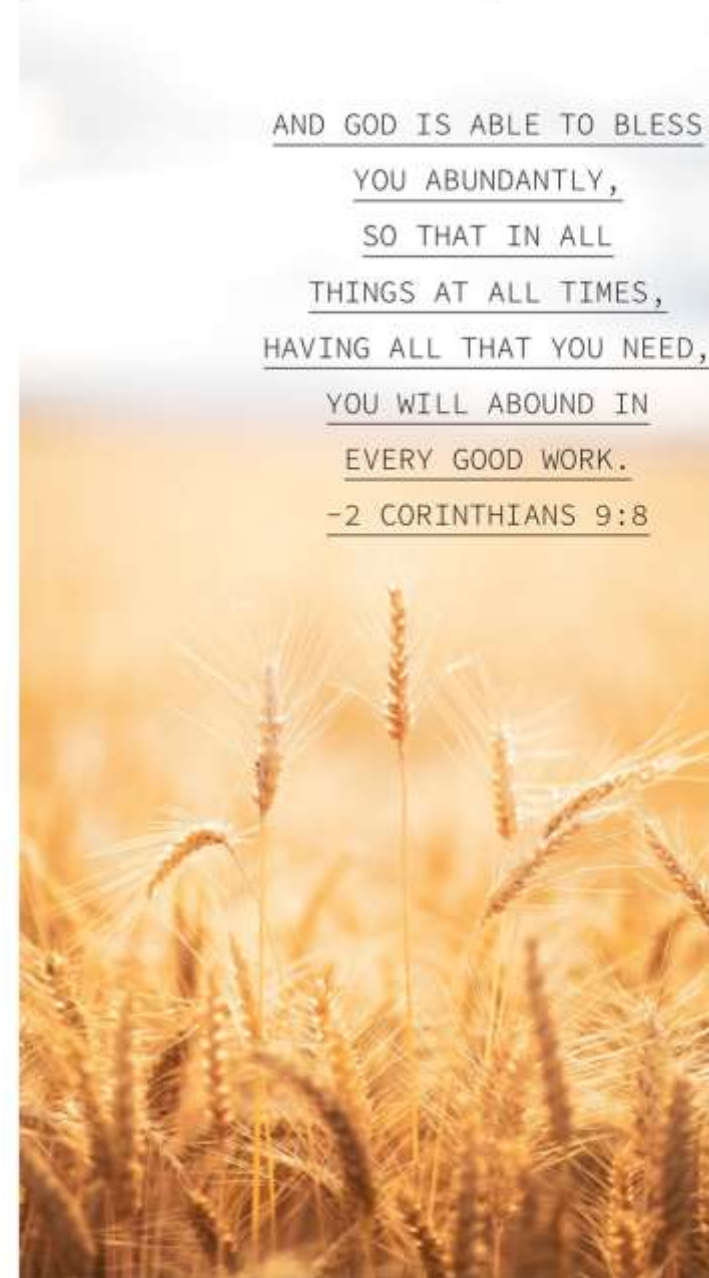

## ***SHOEBOX SEASON NEWS***

Hallelujah ... **It's box packing time!** Needless to say, our “packing party” will look different this year but the task at hand remains the same and we need your help! Classroom #6 is ready to go for a “packing party”. It has been set up with the gifts and supplies for packing into the shoeboxes. We are offering one-hour time slots for packing boxes on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday or Sunday from October 31<sup>st</sup> through November 15<sup>th</sup>. Other days are available upon request. Simply make your request known.

You choose your time slot (or more than one) that works best for you! However, you must sign up in advance and show up on time in order to ensure social distancing can be maintained. For your protection, masks, gloves, hand sanitizer and disinfecting spray will be available. Additionally, at the end of each day, the room will be sanitized. The sign-up sheet is posted on the Mission Committee bulletin board or you may contact Sherry by phone or email to block your time.

Also, if you are going to participate in the “packing party”, we recommend coming prepared with your personal notes and photos of your family to include in the boxes you pack.

Join us in praying for this ministry. **Pray for the children disciplined through the Greatest Journey.** Ask that the millions of shoebox recipients who participate in the 12-lesson, follow-up discipleship program would become lifelong followers of Christ who share their faith with family and friends.

Reminders: **Your shoebox donations and notes of encouragement are due at the church by October 31.** Please place them in the receptacles in the Narthex or request they be picked up at your home. To pack personal boxes, empty shoeboxes are in the Narthex and will be delivered to your home upon request. Completed boxes must be returned to the church (in the Volunteer's Office) by November 22<sup>nd</sup>.
