TRANSITION PLAN FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS

Kentucky's Child Care Regulations state that children who are toddlers (under 36 months of age) must not be blended with older children for care. It is our belief that children are more successful when they are allowed to remain in the same room with their friends, as opposed to being promoted one at a time into a new classroom. As the children enrolled in our Two-Year-Room (Toddlers) celebrate their third birthdays, our staff will ensure that the classroom is continuously updated so that programming and equipment is age and developmentally appropriate for each child in the group. Instead of promoting your child to a new classroom on their third birthday – we will remain as a group for this school year. We believe this is the best setting for your child and look forward to a wonderful year.
