OUT OF CHAOS, HOPE

Emergency Hygiene Kits are needed:

PACK ITEMS IN A GALLON SIZE ZIPLOC BAG

ITEMS NEEDED:

- Hand Towels (16" x 28") — (No other sizes!)
- Washcloths
- Wide-tooth comb
- Nail clippers
- Bath size bar of soap (individually wrapped)
- Toothbrushes (individually packaged)
- 6 Band Aids
