This position requires substantial knowledge of general accounting principles, QuickBooks and Excel, and will work with the Church/Financial Secretary who does the day-to-day tasks.

The Financial Administrator is responsible for preparing month-end close reports, including P&L and balance sheet statements; quarterly tax returns; year-end close including W-2s and 1099s. A yearly budget must be prepared, working with committee chairs, and presented to the Finance Committee. The Financial Administrator serves as the primary financial contact with the Finance Committee.
