Update from TPW

Two deliveries of Trinity's donated items were made on the same day! 10/27/22 Wellstone Behavioral Hospital: Carrie Dodson, Director of Nursing, gladly accepted our donations of devotionals, Bibles, and other Christian materials. She said adults particularly loved the small devotionals when undergoing therapy and frequently asked for them. A generous donation from Sisters in Christ Sunday School Class will provide a one year's subscription of These Days that will be delivered directly to the hospital for distribution. This will allow some of the devotionals to be read during the current year. Bibles are also requested, and permission is given for the patients to take them home after group therapy or in-patient stays. Carrie noted the acute needs of children brought to the hospital. Frequently, no one wants them, not parents or grandparents, and they have no social contacts for support. Our prayers for this hospital's patients are needed.

Inventory delivered: 21 Bibles, 6 Bible study guides, and 74 devotionals. All items were in "like new" condition. A sign saying "Christian Materials Donated by Trinity Presbyterian Church" was provided to display in the hospital as staff sees fit.

Lifeshouse Maternity Home: Collecting boxes had spilled over and were gathered together for the delivery. A recent presentation by Katie Rankin, Program and Operations Director, to the Sew 'n Sews indicated an emergency state of supply needs. Our congregation answered the call!!

Inventory delivered: 105 disposable diapers, 2 changing tables, 48 rolls of paper towels, 36 bibs, 30 onsies (donated by OCC), 7 blankets, 12 baby socks, 24 AAA batteries, 4 LED lightbulbs, 1 cutting board, 2 bottles DREFT detergent, 2 bottles TIDE Free detergent, 7 baby blankets, 4 bed pillows, 8 decorative pillows made by Sew 'n Sews, 10 *One minute inspiration for women* devotional booklets.

Thank you, Trinity Congregation for the generosity of supplies donated to these two non-profit organizations. We could not have done this without our collective love of ministries to the marginalized of our community. Well done, good and faithful servants.
