The Shining Star Quilt Block Pattern

"And God made the gwo great lights – the greater light (the sun) to rule the day, and the lesser light (the moon) to rule the night."

Genesis 1:16

History of the Pattern: The block features a single large star, with four extended points made from colorful half triangle quilt blocks, suggesting twinkling star movements.

Plain white blocks surrounding the star give an impression of ambient light emitted from the moon and companion stars.

The overall effect may remind us of the joy of observing the expanse of the heavens in a clear dark sky.

The items being collected are:


