Starting today (Jan 4) you can now make an online contribution is one of three ways. The online giving form is the same in each of the three methods listed below.

To get started:

1. The mobile app **Connect** is a quick and easy way to give. Login to your account and then touch **Giving**, then **Give Now** and complete the form. On this same page you can view or enter a Pledge and see your 2026 contribution history.

2. Go to <https://onrealm.org/TrinityPresbyte9279/> and touch the **Give Online** button and complete the form.

3. Scan the **QR code** printed in the bulletin and complete the form.

To complete the form simply fill in the boxes and decide if it is a **Give Once** or **Multiple Times** (recurring) and touch your choice. The form defaults to **Online Giving** (general operating fund). You may contribute to any of the designated funds such as Flowers, Art Studio, etc. by touching the down arrow and touching the choice. If this is your first time using this form after you touch **Continue** you enter either **Credit/Debit** card or **Bank Account (EFT) information**, and then confirm your amount.
