## A Message from Carrie Gerard of EACM (Eastern Area Community Ministries)

Hello Friends of EACM:

The Mayor has proposed flat funding for the community ministries in the 26/27 Metro Budget, despite making a \$500,000 mid-year budget adjustment in the 25/26 Metro budget. The community ministries' ask is to maintain the allocation for community ministries with the mid-year adjustment = \$2,165,000. EACM would receive \$197,000 restricted for Emergency Assistance.

The need to support our neighbors in this time of economic challenges is increasing. Housing, Foot, Utilities are all up in cost. I just spoke with a neighbor last week whose rent went up from \$675 per month to \$945 per month with NO warning.

The Council is currently negotiating on changes to the Metro Budget.

Your comments as a constituent are one of the most powerful ways to sway Council to provide critical funding for the support of the community ministries.
