It has been brought to our attention that some people are having difficulty specifying a particular cause or fund when they are giving online.

Once you’ve signed in to your Connect mobile app, click on the “Give Now” button. That will take you to a box where you can enter the amount you wish to contribute. Underneath where you enter the amount, there are the words “Operating Fund Contribution”, which is the default fund for your donation.

If you click on those words (Operating Fund Contribution), a list of other available funds will appear, i.e. Flower Fund, Sanctuary Lighting, etc. You can choose any of those funds by clicking on the name.

If you leave it on Operating Fund, your donation will go to the general operating fund of the church and will be credited as a donation, or payment on your pledge if you are a pledger.
