Future studies will be shaped by the interests of the class and may include contemporary issues such as peacemaking, the environment, immigration, and economic equity, as well as Bible studies focused on particular books or groups of books and special Advent and Lenten studies. The plan is to offer shorter studies than in the past.

The class is convened by Rev. Bob Williams-Neal, with a format that varies between presentation and open discussion. Participants are encouraged to ask questions and share insights in an informal setting. A variety of resources - including books, readings, and multimedia - will be used.

This year, the Equipped to Engage class will embark on a study called THRIVE. The premise of this class is:

1. Human beings were made by God for a particular kind of life.
2. Because of sin, our lives have become disordered and we seek happiness in countless places in place of God.
3. The gospel does more than forgive our sins or secure our eternal destiny. The gospel is God's means of restoring us to the kind of life for which we were created.
4. Christian flourishing is not simply 'living your best life' - it is becoming through Christ the people God created us to be and learning to live according to God's good design.

Join us and discover how to live into the fullness of Christ's redeeming work. We meet downstairs in Classroom #6 from 9:15-10:15 AM.

YOUTH GROUP

Sundays, 9:45-10:15 AM | Downstairs, Youth Room

This fall, the Youth Group will use Bible Studies for Life: Students, a 13-session study designed to help students grow as disciples of Jesus and apply Scripture to their everyday lives.

The study is organized around three themes: A Living Example, exploring what it means to live as an example of Jesus; Obedience God's Way, discovering the importance of following God's Word; and Under One Roof, considering how our faith shapes the way we live and have a kingdom impact within our families. Each session connects biblical truth to real-life situations and gives students practical ways to live out their faith.

Students will also have Daily Discipleship Guides with five short devotionals each week, helping them continue engaging with God's Word between youth group meetings.
