Every gift to Trinity Presbyterian Church helps us share Christ's love through worship, service, and outreach.

There are many ways to support Trinity. While cash and checks are familiar ways to give we will discuss additional ways in the next 6 bulletin series, other assets—such as retirement accounts, appreciated investments, and estate gifts—may provide additional opportunities for generosity and, in some circumstances, tax advantages.

The goal is not simply to decide **how much to give**, but also consider **what is the most effective way to give** based on your individual circumstances.

Traditional Ways of Giving

Place your cash or check gift in the offering plate on Sunday or mail it to the church office.

Or Online Giving



Make a secure one-time or recurring gift through **Realm Connect**.

Scan the QR code to give online.

Online giving allows you to conveniently make one-time or recurring gifts using a bank account or other available payment method.

Or ACH or Bank Bill Pay

Set up recurring gifts directly from your checking or savings account.

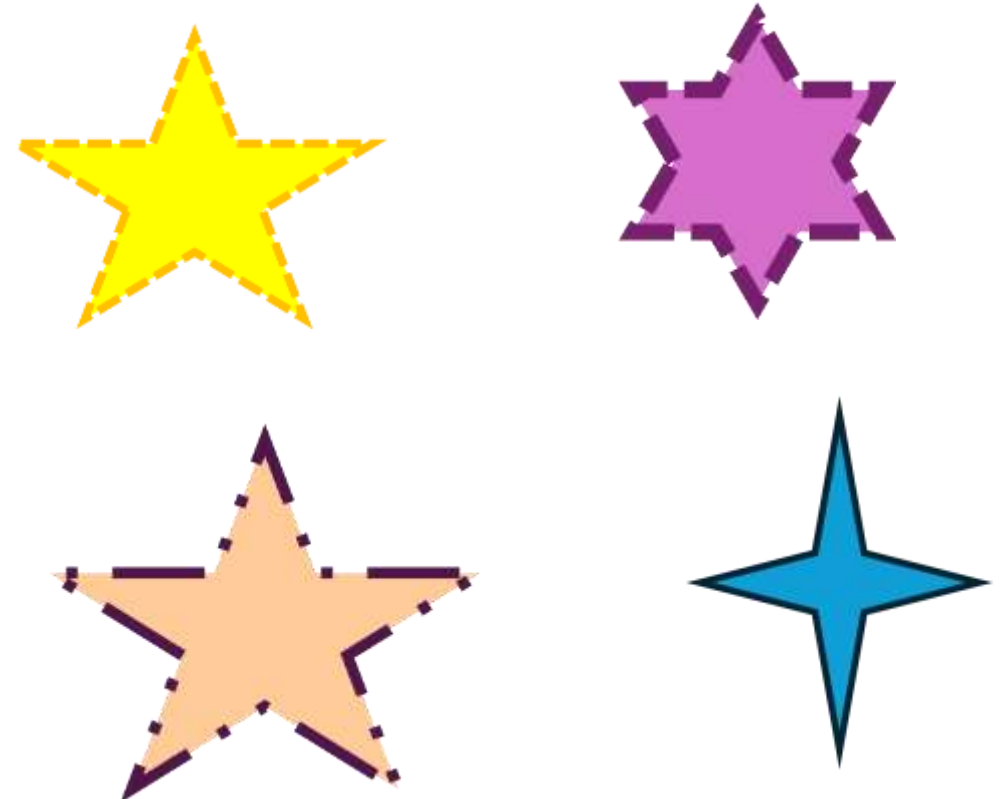
Your bank may also allow you to establish Trinity as a recurring payment through its online bill-pay service.

Automatic giving can provide a simple and consistent way to support Trinity throughout the year.

Children of all ages, please visit the Shining Star Center in the Narthex. The area includes Sunday activity sheets, crayons/colored pencils and squishys/stress balls. Though this is primarily for preschool or school age children, adults are allowed. Sometimes we all need a fidget toy to help focus our attention during the service.

The small table will provide space for parents/adults to bring their children out of the sanctuary to color or quietly play while mom or dad can still provide a watchful eye and listen to the church service. Though there are other activities for children during worship, sometimes leaving the comfort of family is difficult.

Crayons and colored pencils may be taken home after the service and brought back and used again the next Sunday or if forgotten at home please feel free to take a new set. Finally, small squishy toys because of size are more appropriate for the older children and adults. Because this is a new venture, things will be updated on a regular basis.
